Traffic & Pedestrian Management

Traffic and pedestrian management measures are erected to provide safe routes for persons passing through the works and to ensure we segregate the works area from the public.

Progress Update:

Site Clearance and Fencing Hedgerow and tree clearance works are practically complete along the project. Vegetation will be cleared from site during December for use as a biofuel. Fencing is complete to any unsecured boundaries.



Roadworks and Drainage The section of the southbound carriageway outside the church and school was opened to traffic on 5th November 2018.

The boundary wall to the church has been re-built using the same stone, overseen by local stonemason, Sean McQuillan, who built the wall first time round.

Culverts

Despite some technical issues, we successfully installed the cattle underpass over the weekend of 17th-19th August 2018 and opened the road before the planned time on Monday morning.

Works Planned in next 8 weeks:

Roadworks and Drainage We have commenced works on the northbound carriageway opposite the school and church. We have also commenced the road works and drainage for the new southbound carriageway opposite the L1160 and also at Glennan Rd (L5207) tying into the new carriageway outside the school. Glennan Rd is closed until 21st December 2018 to allow the construction of the new junction with level differences.

It is planned that the northbound carriageway opposite the school and the southbound carriageway between chainage 1500 and the school including the Glennan Rd tie-in will be completed before the Christmas holidays and open to traffic.

However for a number of months there will be no right turn from the Glennan Rd onto or from the N2 due to the level difference between the new and existing road.

A dewatering trial has been set-up on the northbound verge just north of the Tydavnet Road (L1170).

Culverts/Structures The remaining culverts will now be constructed in May/June next year. Works to complete the wingwalls to the cattle underpass will be undertaken early next year. Works to two retaining walls just south of the Glennan Rd junction will be done before Christmas.

It is planned to remove traffic management from the road over the Christmas Holidays (22/12/18-6/1/19)
